We are actively seeking manufacturing business partners in the Western New York region to provide experiential learning and employment opportunities.

Participants in Goodskills undergo an assessment process, receive sector specific job readiness training, and are pre-screened to ensure they meet your company's specific needs. Upon completing the four-week training, all Goodskills graduates have OSHA 10 certification, forklift experience, completed a shop math course, CyberSAFE Certification, are knowledgeable in Precision and Measurements, and received an Introduction to Blueprint Reading.
